NEW BUSINESS

SLOVAK FOLK CRAFTS REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF SITE PLAN

David Dayton presented his request for a waiver of the Site Plan requirements of the Springfield Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance 9-94 for the construction of a parking lot. The project is required to accommodate increased customer traffic due to the temporarily housing of Wendell August’s retail operation due to fire at their facility in Grove City Borough.

After hearing the proposal and public comment from members of the Springfield Township Planning Commission, and Twp. Residents, a motion was made by Gary Hartman and second by Judy Hassler to approve the request for a waiver of submission of site plan with the following conditions:

- 1) The parking area must be at least 10 feet from the property line.
- 2) The entrance and exit from Route 208 (South Center Street) and your property must be marked to facilitate the flow of traffic with pavement markings.

- 3) A Professional Engineer's statement must be provided to the township indicating any stormwater runoff from the new gravel parking area will be de minimus and will not impact the neighboring properties.
- 4) The parking lot will be limestone gravel, and will not be paved with impervious material.

Motion carried, vote was unanimous.
