CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Springfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date in the Township Building at 1791 Perry Highway, Volant. Chairman, Don Bonner called the meeting to order with the “Pledge of Allegiance” at 9:00 a.m.

OLD BUSINESS

TOWNSHIP FIREHALL BUILDING COLOR SELECTIONS

The Supervisors reviewed samples of flooring, ceiling tiles, doors, etc. and made various selections of designs and colors. The Supervisors asked Barb to be the main point of contact on the building project and to report back to the Board of Supervisors.

TOWNSHIP BUILDING BLOCK VS. DRYVIT

A motion was made by Don Bonner and second by Gary Hartman that all the face of the building is to be all block vs. dryvit. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

WETLAND ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

Don discussed the Wetland Encroachment Permit. He stated that the regulations were changing and would be stricter and felt the Township should take some action now. He suggested grading off and putting gravel down and that would allow use of the dry portion of the lot and keep wet lands from expanding. A motion was made by Gary Hartman and second by Judy Hassler to proceed with wetland project. Don is to be the main contact for Ross concerning the wetlands project. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

12th CONGRESSIONAL REGION EQUIPMENT CO., INC. & REHABILITATION OF MANHOLES

A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to sign the contract to join the 12th Congressional Region Equipment Co., Inc. We can then proceed with Insight Pipe Contracting, L.P. and the rehabilitation of the manholes. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

HIRING OF NEW ROAD WORKER (NOV 1ST TO APRIL 15TH)

A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to proceed with hiring a new employee for road work. Don opposed. He stated that the Township needed to be sure of what it was doing.

A motion was then made by Judy Hassler and Gary Hartman second rescinding the previous motion to hire a new employee for road work.

After some discussion, a motion was then made by Gary Hartman and second by Judy Hassler to advertise for a part time help for road work at a rate \$12.00 guarantee of 20 hours a week but to run from November 1, 2010 to April 15, 2011. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

PRIMANTI BROTHERS HIGHWAY OCCUPANCY PERMIT

A motion was made by Gary Hartman and second by Judy Hassler to send a letter from the Board of Supervisors to PennDot addressing their concerns of left hand turns into Primanti's. They would prefer that barriers are be used to prevent left hand turns. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.
