CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Springfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date in the Township Building at 1791 Perry Highway, Volant. Vice Chairman, Gary Hartman called the meeting to order with the "Pledge of Allegiance" at 9:10 a.m.

SALE OF TOWNSHIP PROPERTY

Barb had provided information to the Supervisors that she received from Lucy Wann of Coldwell Banker Real Estate saying she thought the estimated value of the Township property on Rt. 208 would be worth approximately \$50,000.

OLD BUSINESS

ORDINANCE #3-2010 - MOTOR VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT

A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to adopt Ordinance #3-2010 imposing restrictions as to the weight of vehicles operated upon certain township roads; providing for the issuance of permits for movement of vehicles of weights in excess of limits; for restrictions; and prescribing penalties for violations. Motion carried with both Supervisors voting yes.

DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

Barb had left copies of the most recent Development Agreement between Springfield Township and Wal-Mart Stores for the Supervisors to review.

JIM KNIGHT / DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS / ROADMASTER**ROAD WORK**

Jim provided the Supervisors with the dirt road treatment estimates for Holstein Lane, Bottle Hill Road, and Church Road per request from last meeting. There was some discussion on prioritizing the needs of roads and bringing back additional information for the next meeting. Gary discussed the Supervisors going on a road check.

WEIGHT LIMIT SIGN ESTIMATES

Jim presented the Supervisors with estimates of from Ibis Signs-\$2,769.68, Econo Signs-\$3640.20 and Walsh Equipment-\$2,542.35. Walsh equipment was cheapest.

Jim stated that there had been continuing problems with the flow meter and he and Barb were looking into getting them resolved.
