PROJECT STATUS

The Supervisor reviewed the letter that was being sent to D. J. Hannon, concerning the sprinkler system being completed by August 31, 2011. This was approved at August 2nd meeting.

CLEANING SERVICE FOR NEW TOWNSHIP BUILDING

A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to purchase 10-6' Alera Resin tables @ \$102.38 each, Alera 1cart @ \$258.85, 19 boxes of Alera Grey Chairs w/vinyl @ \$83.74 (4 per box), and Safco double tier chair rack @ \$250.00. Total cost per quote \$3,123.71. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to approve the changes that Ray Bogaty had been requested to make to the Fire Department Lease, and sign the lease. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

ELECTIONS OFFICE REQUEST TO USE BUILDING AS POLL FOR SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP EAST

A request was received from Jeffrey W. Greenburg, Director of Elections, Mercer County to use the new Springfield Township Building as the Elections office for Springfield Township East. A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to approve the request to use the Springfield Township building as the Poll for Springfield Township East, and to close the office for Election Days. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE HOUSING PRESERVATION GRANT

A motion was made by Judy Hassler and second by Gary Hartman to work with Grove City Borough and Liberty Township in pursuit of United States Department of Agriculture Housing Preservation Grant. This would provide monies to existing housing rehabilitation program in the borough and two townships. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.
