**CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Springfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date in the Township Building at 1791 Perry Highway, Volant. Chair, Judy Hassler called the meeting to order with the “Pledge of Allegiance” at 9:00 a.m.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

**PROJECT STATUS**

Barb stated that Veon wanted something in writing that stated that the Township would release them from any liquidating damages against them. The Supervisors did not agree, they felt that Veon is responsible for a year, it to sign any type of agreement would reduce their liability.

**DRAW REQUEST VEON CONSTRUCTION & D. J. HANNON**

A motion was made by Don Bonner and second by Gary Hartman to approve the draft requests for Veon in the amount of \$57,186.63 and D. J. Hannon & Sons – Plumbing # 5 for \$11,501.91 & HVAC # 3 for \$2,241.44. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

**CLEANING SERVICE FOR NEW TOWNSHIP BUILDING**

A motion was made by Don Bonner and second by Gary Hartman to advertise for a cleaning service to clean the office once a month. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.

**GROVE CITY WASTEWATER TREATMENT COST OF SHARE OF CAPACITY**

The Supervisors received documentation with an explanation of how the Wastewater Treatment Cost share of capacity was calculated. A motion was made by Don Bonner and second by Gary Hartman to have release Springfield Townships share of capacity cost for the engineering fees of the failed expansion project to Grove City Borough. Motion carried, vote was unanimous. The Supervisors asked to have HRG review how calculation of \$110,000 share of capacity was done and to make sure it was based on 115,000 and not the 196,000 gallons of capacity and verify information on behalf of Springfield Township.

Don voiced his concern about current tap fees. Barb said that Ray was looking at agreements to see where we stand.

**CURRENT TOWNSHIP OFFICE BIDS**

No bids were received for the old Township building that was advertised. Barb is to check with Grove City Hospital to see if they want the old Township office and if not rebid for sale.

**NEW BUSINESS****FIRE POLICE REQUEST SHEAKLEYVILLE FAIR**

Al Pierce requested permission from the Supervisors for the Fire Police to work at the Sheakleyville Volunteer Fire Department Homecoming Parade directing traffic starting August 2, 2011. A motion was made by Gary Hartman and second by Don Bonner to approve the above. Motion carried, vote was unanimous.
