

RESOLUTION # 19 of 2010

Fees for Administration of the Springfield Township Alarm Ordinance

WHEREAS, Springfield Township has enacted the Springfield Township Alarm Ordinance #1 of 2010 for the purposes set forth in The Springfield Township Alarm Ordinance #1-2010:

WHEREAS, it is necessary, and in the best interest of the Township and its residents that fees be established, to be paid to the Township to defray the costs of general administration and enforcement of the ordinance;


Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Springfield Township Board of Supervisors that a schedule of fees to be paid to the Township for the administration and enforcement of the Alarm Ordinance, which shall be, and is hereby established as follows:

At the time of filing of an application, the applicant shall pay a fee based on the following:


\$50.00 for all Non-residential Alarm Systems for initial registration, which shall be valid for 1 year


\$25.00 for annual Renewal of Registration
