**SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
BUSINESS MEETING**

JULY 20, 2026

Present: Supervisors Marcus Kohan, Tim Stiffy, and Willie Hohmann. Also present, Road Foreman Jim Knight and Township Administrator Lucinda Lipko.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes, Bill List and Payroll:

Tim Stiffy made a motion to approve the following:

Administration and Finance.

Tim Stiffy made a motion to approve the 2027 MMO for the Non-Uniform Employee Pension Plan in the amount of \$ 14,103.00. Seconded by Willie Hohmann, motion carried.

Tim Stiffy made a motion to retroactively approve the request of the Springfield Township Volunteer Fire Department for a 5-year Non Destructive Testing for the Ariel apparatus in the amount of \$ 1,177.00 per the Fire Agreement. Seconded by Willie Homann, motion carried.

Tim Stiffy made a motion to approve an administrative change to Paragraph g of the Fire Agreement of January 19, 2023 to raise the single item purchase to \$ 1,500.00 before prior approval is required. Seconded by Willie Hohmann, motion carried.

Tim Stiffy made a motion to adopt the bond recommendation from Gateway Engineers, dated July 7, 2026, for Cobblehaus Brewing Company contingent on final post adoption review and approval by Gateway Engineers and Township Solicitor, and acceptance of any ancillary documents. Seconded by Willie Hohmann, motion carried.

Sewer and Water:

Road Foreman Jim Knight reported that the sewer bid opening was last week and we did not receive any bids. The project will be advertised again, and the opening will be August 26, 2026.

Roads and Bridges

Jim Knight reported that the pipe was replaced on Old Ash Road dead end.

Old Mercer Road from Millburn Road to the Township line lost the whole road with run off. It is now open and they are working to push the ditches back. Would like to keep the water on the road and let it run over to the creek.

The Fire Chief has approved the following requests for Fire Police:

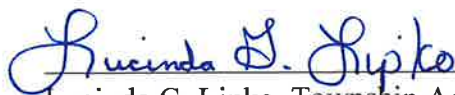
