

**SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA
RESOLUTION # 7 - 2006**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, SETTING AND IMPOSING A SEWER TAPPING FEE TO BE CHARGED UPON OWNERS OF PROPERTY IN SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP CONNECTION TO THE PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 57 OF 2003 AND SECTION 406 OF ORDINANCE # 3 - 1994 OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Springfield Township have enacted an ordinance regulating connection to the public sewage systems; requiring a permit to connect to the public sewage system; providing for sewer charges; and prescribing penalties for violation; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 406 of said ordinance, The Township is specifically authorized to impose a Tapping Fee upon all property owners who connect to the sewer systems; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors by the Resolution desires to set the amount of the Tapping Fee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Springfield Township, and Springfield Township resolves the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be imposed upon all property owners in Springfield Township who connect to the sanitary sewer system a Tapping Fee in the amount of \$4050 per EDU which fee shall be based upon the following components:

Capacity Component	\$ 3300.00 per EDU
Collection Component	\$ 750.00 per EDU
TOTAL TAP FEE	\$ 4050.00 per EDU
(Reimbursement Component	\$ 712.50 per EDU)

SECTION 2. The Tapping Fee established in this Resolution utilizes an average customer sewage discharge including Infiltration/Inflow, equivalent to 247 gallons per day (GPD)/EDU in accordance with the requirements set forth in Act 57 of 2003, and as authorized in Section 406 of Ordinance # 3-1994 of Springfield Township. The calculation of EDU's shall be calculated in accordance with the Sewage Flow Tables in 25 PA Code Section 73.17. Payment of a Tap-in Fee as well as continued monthly payments of 60% the monthly sewer user fee per EDU, will reserve the allocated capacity in the Township' Sewage Facilities for the property. If construction activities have not commenced on said property within a period of 1 year, the Tap-in Fee will

be returned to the property owner, without interest, and the capacity reserved in the Township's Sewage Facilities will be revoked.

SECTION 3. The amount of the Tapping fee is based upon computations and calculations of Gannett Flemming, Inc., Consulting Engineers to Springfield Township, in a report dated February 2005, as specifically set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached and make part of this Resolution and capacity component as set by the Borough of Grove City.
